Teams from the Presbytery of the James will assist with Hurricane Florence recovery in New Bern, North Carolina. The first trip, October 7-14, will involve primarily cleaning out homes and assessing the damage for additional response. A second trip is planned for November 11-16. The effort is led by Brown Pearson, an elder at Southminster Presbyterian Church, who brings 15 years of experience in disaster recovery on the Gulf Coast, West Virginia, and Florida.
