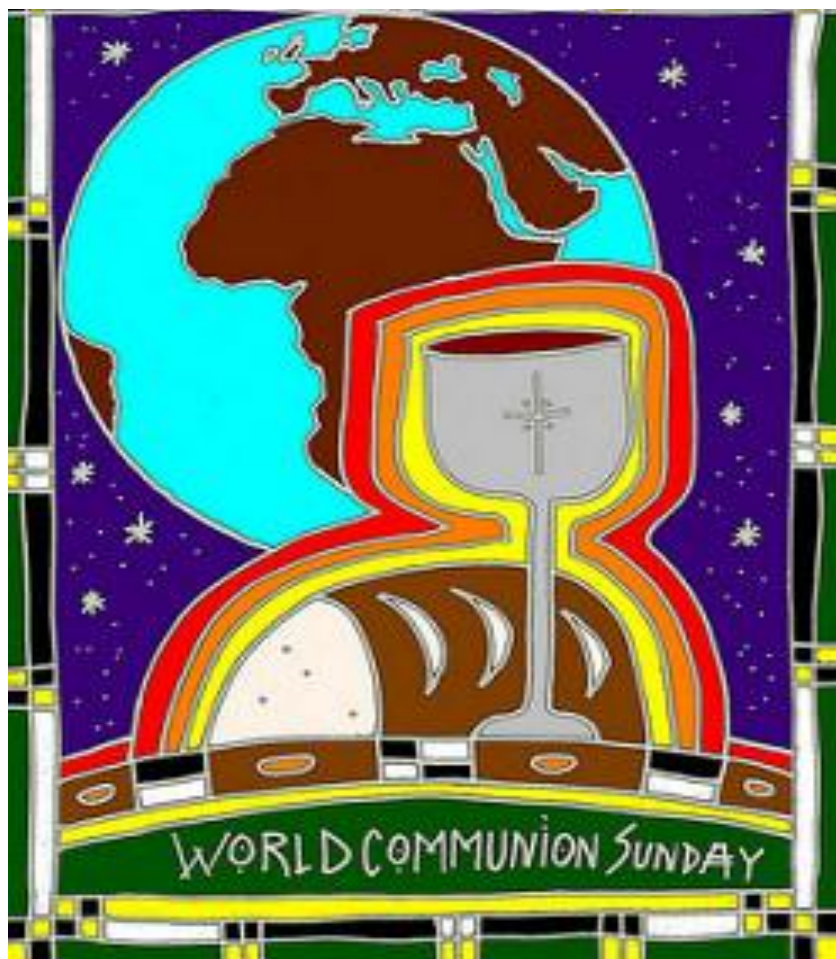
*PRAYER OF CONFESSION
