

A Note from the Church Treasurer: Applause! Applause! Applause! At of the end of the second quarter of our fiscal year (June 30, 2019), members of our congregation and guests had provided \$247,525.86 in envelope contributions toward the operating budget figure of \$492,850.00 in envelope contributions for the year (50.22%). Additionally, Tuckahoe had received

\$944.25 in loose offering and \$931.50 for the CentsAbility program. Sixty per cent of the CentsAbility contributions are forwarded to the Presbytery of the James for use in their hunger program in Central Virginia and Haiti. The remainder of the contributions underwrites the costs associated with our lunch program for Liberation Family Services. Finally, our church received \$622.00 in contributions to the Pentecost Offering and \$1,271.00 for the One Great Hour of Sharing (Easter Offering). Forty per cent of the Pentecost Offering remains at TPC to support programs for children at risk. On behalf of the Stewardship & Finance Committee and other session committees, I would like to express our gratitude for your continued generosity.
