<u>G-1.01</u> The Congregation

- Local church engaged in the mission of God in a particular context
- God gives the congregation the gifts needed
- Ministries: proclamation, sacrament, covenant life

- ► Governance




<u>G-1.02</u> The Organizing of a Congregation

- New Congregations apply to Presbytery
- Founding member covenant using specific vows
 - Desire to form congregation
 - Life in unity
 - Work together in ministry as disciples of Jesus
- Admission is up to Presbytery
- Presbytery helps to stand up approved new congregations

G-1.05 Meetings of Congregation

- Meetings shall be opened/closed in prayer.
- Special meetings -> congregation shall hold meetings as necessary; all present members are entitled to vote.
- Session, Presbytery, or by Session in writing by 1/4 active members.
- Business is limited at these meetings **G. I.0504**
- Moderator -> installed pastor or minister from Presbytery
- Clerk of Session -> secretary

G-1.0504 Congregational Powers

Matters related to the following:

- I. electing ruling elders, deacons, trustees
- > 2. calling a pastor, co-pastor, or associate pastor
- S. changing existing pastoral relationship by reviewing terms of call for installed pastors
- ▶ 4. buying, mortgaging, or selling real property.

Congregational Powers (continued)

- 5. requesting from presbytery an exemption as permitted in the constitution
- 6. approving plan for creation of a joint congregational witness or amending or dissolve said witness
- 7. receiving a discipline decision against a member of the congregation as required in D-9.0102
