**\*AFFIRMATION OF FAITH – FROM A BRIEF STATEMENT OF FAITH**

It was drafted to celebrate the 1983 reunion of the two largest Presbyterian denominations in the United States. It is officially included in the denomination's Book of Confessions. Its themes include the Triune God, creation, grace and redemption, hope, inclusive language, and gender equality. -PCUSA Website*

**We trust in God, whom Jesus called Abba, Father. In sovereign love, God created the world good and made everyone equally in God’s image, of every race and people, to live as one community. But we rebel against God; we hide from our Creator. Ignoring God’s commandments, we violate the image of God in others and ourselves, accept lies as truth, exploit neighbors and nature, and threaten death to the planet entrusted to our care. We deserve God’s condemnation. Yet God acts with justice and mercy to redeem creation. In everlasting love, the God of Abraham and Sarah chose a covenant people to bless all families of the earth. Hearing their cry, God delivered the children of Israel from the house of bondage. Loving us still, God makes us heirs with Christ of the covenant. Like a mother who will not forsake her nursing child, like a father who runs to welcome the prodigal home, God is faithful still.**
